



MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS


Sophomores who attended SVA their freshman year are eligible for the GHRoW Merit Scholarships. SVA recommends several students to apply for the Merit Scholarship based on financial need and academic performance. The eligible students submit an application which includes a short essay describing themselves and their interests. Each year the GHRoW board awards a minimum of \$10,000 to at least one student and the balance of the funds remaining are awarded to as many students as possible. The total award amount often changes from year to year as it depends upon the total funds received in donations.



2021-2022 AWARDS

Four GHRoW Merit Scholarships totaling \$32,000 were awarded to Kevin Guzman, Esther Rapley, Rebecca Reis, and Salome Tembo. Esther received the principal Merit Scholarship this year. As with all merit scholarships, ½ of the scholarship award was applied to the student's SVA account during the school year. The balance of the scholarship will be applied during the student's Junior and Senior years at SVA.

During 2021–2022 there were a total of 22 GHRoW Merit scholars at SVA representing \$167,000 in Merit Scholarships.

R. SCOTT HANDEL LEADERSHIP SCHOLARSHIP


The 13th annual R. Scott Handel Leadership Scholarship, along with \$2,500, was awarded to Junior class president, Kristiana Hoffman. Kristiana was the first student to receive the leadership scholarship more than once.

Last year Kristiana was involved in several SVA music programs (Orchestra, Strings Ensemble, and Handbells) as well as competing on the swim team. She was also involved in the local Civil Air Patrol as she has a keen interest in flying. She also managed to work 30 hours a week at McDonalds to help pay for her education.

MILESTONES

On August 8, 1991 GHRoW began with four SVA alumni, forty dollars, and a desire to give back to SVA – the school that had blessed them.

On August 8, 2021 the GHRoW Board met for lunch in Olney, Maryland to celebrate our 30th anniversary. All former board members and family were invited. Over lunch they read thank you notes from GHRoW scholars and prepared gift boxes for the current scholars. Anniversary scholarships (\$530 each) were awarded to 12 SVA students in honor of the anniversary. Everyone reflected on the many ways God has blessed SVA students through GHRoW supporters and scholarships.
